

The Resident Edinburgh Pet Policy

We are delighted to welcome your furry friend on your visit to our pet friendly city, Edinburgh.

To ensure we get along, we just ask that you follow a few house rules while staying with us;

o All well-behaved dogs are welcome for an additional charge of £30 per night per pet

o Guide dogs are welcome on a complimentary basis

o Dogs must be kept on leash or carried in all public places at The Resident Edinburgh

o We must insist that your dogs are well-behaved and most importantly house trained

o The only place for them to use the toilet is outside of the hotel, where we would be delighted to point you in the right direction of some furbulous walks.

o You must be present while any member of the hotel cleaning or maintenance team is in the room with your pet

o We ask you to consider the comfort of other guests and their pets when you are relaxing the Lounge or Library on the ground floor to keep your dog on a leash and off the furniture

o In the unlikely event of an emergency, we will call a vet, and it is not our responsibility for any outcome or cost

o We will check the room upon checkout and if your pet causes any damage or heavyduty mess, we will charge you for any repairs/deep cleaning incurred

o Dogs cannot be left unattended in the room, this is for their own safety and wellbeing

o Please do ensure that your pets are up to date with their vaccinations and flea and tick control. This is to safeguard any other pets that may be guests at The Resident Edinburgh and to also ensure that pest infestations are kept away.
